Sources told the pub, "Slimane has expressed his frustration to Vogue global director and Condé Nast chief content officer Anna Wintour and hit the brakes on some advertising with the Vogue brand."

A source close to the magazine told Page Six. "It is Hedi's decision not to work with Vogue," and they have "nothing but respect and admiration for him and look forward to covering

Celine in the future."
